Mission


- To make room for all learners to develop their potential and acquire necessary skills which will make them marketable and thus

Welcome to our team Thandile! Thandile is a dedicated rugby coach and will be helping our school with initiatives and Cami English and Maths in our computer lab.






Welcome 2018






SCI-FEST 2018
